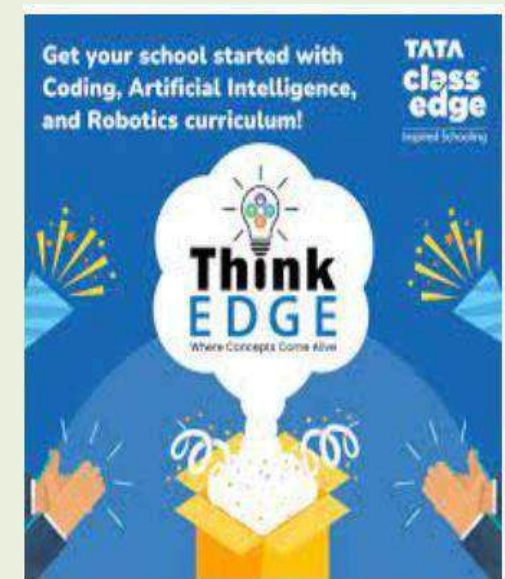
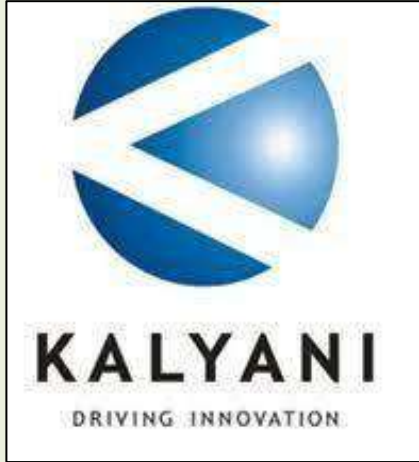

Infrastructure Details

- **A Central Courtyard**
- A delightful area representing the life space of the school, which provides ample space for assembly, sports and for children to explore, learn and mingle.
- **Smart Classes**
- Our classrooms are unshackled learning spaces which have flexible seating arrangements and audio-video facilities for effective learning. A class size of 30 students ensures good student-teacher interaction and individual attention.
- **Library / Information Centre**
- To carry forward academic excellence, the school provides a well-stocked library to its students. The Library set-up consists of two libraries - The Junior Library and The Senior Library. The Junior Library is mainly meant for students up to Grade V and the Senior Library for students from Grade VI upwards. The libraries have carefully chosen, age appropriate books targeted towards fun and learning. Apart from educational books, the students have access to a variety of fiction and informative books to read, learn and have fun from. We have a Reading program for Grades Jr. KG to III, effectively lead by a 'Reading Specialist.'

- **Activity Rooms**
- Activity Rooms to foster creativity and expand the artistic qualities of our students. The school provides expansive studios for Art and Craft, Clay, Dance, Music, Theatre and Sports for better holistic development of the students.
- **Laboratories**
- State of the art laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computers, Robotics, Home Science and Math. These facilities give the students an opportunity to apply their theoretical knowledge to practical applications.
- **Learning Terraces**
- We understand that confining learning to within four walls can be very boring and monotonous at times, so we have provided our students and teachers with open learning terraces where they can have curriculum based studies in the open. These open spaces also provide a platform to facilitate learning through various educational and recreational activities to develop the interactive skills and overall personality of the students.
- **Audio Video Facilities**
- It is said that a picture is better than a thousand words and therefore audio video facilities are very important in a child's process of grasping knowledge.
- Audio Video facilities are available in our digital classrooms for this purpose.

- **Cafeteria**
- A fully functional cafeteria, which serves freshly made, hot, nutritional food. Hygiene and cleanliness is strictly maintained. A welcoming space, where students and teachers can bond and enjoy their meals and also learn good habits.
- **Medical Infirmary**
- First - Aid and Medical care is available to the students whenever required. The stock of most needed medicines and First- Aid materials are replenished before expiry and the students and staff members are provided prompt medical help whenever required. A trained and experienced Nurse is on duty throughout school hours. Annual Health check-ups are also done for all students and the reports are shared with the parents.
- **Auditorium**
- An Auditorium of 12,000 sq. ft. with a capacity to seat more than 750, is being built and will be used for all important school functions like Form Mornings, Graduation Ceremonies, and Founder's Day Events etc. Such opportunities would help students grow in confidence and aspire for their dreams.

- **Multi-Purpose Hall**
- A large hall of 4,000 sq. ft., with a high ceiling, which provides ample space for indoor, educational and recreational activities and indoor Sports like Yoga, Gymnastics, Self-Defense activities etc.
- **Sports Complex**
- An unparalleled 3.5 acre Sports complex with an astroturf field for Football, Cricket and Athletics, permitting sports to be played in all weather conditions. Outdoor and Indoor Basketball courts, Skating rink and Cricket nets. Indoor sports like, Badminton, Table-Tennis etc.

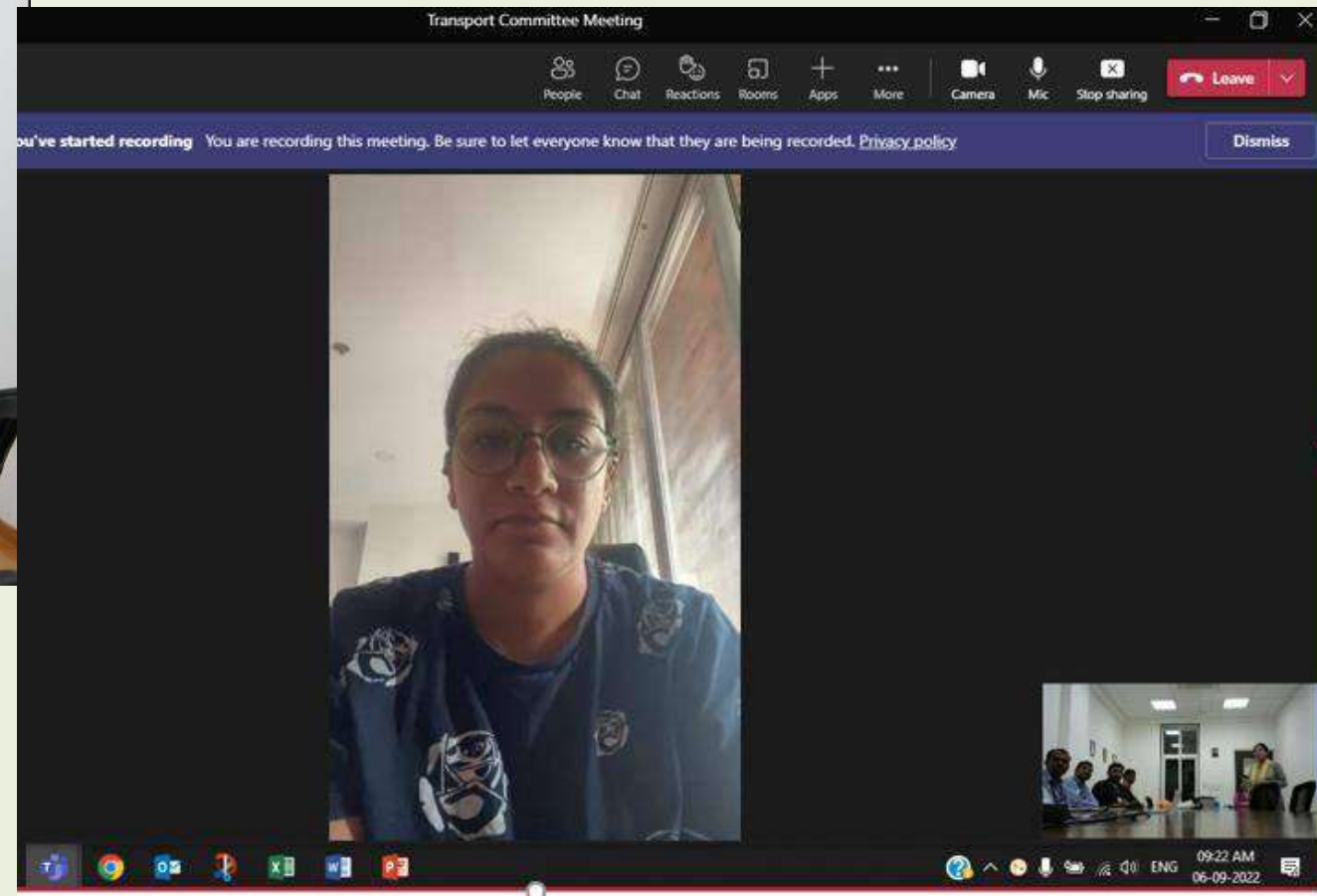

Environment Awareness Activities conducted...

- We have an '**Environment consciousness program**' known as ECP where the kids are not only learning about different aspects of our environment but our motive behind this program is to make them conscious of it. Through this program, we are trying to imbibe the love for nature in the children's heart and soul so that they have a new perspective where they will learn to co-exist with nature rather than ruling on it.
- We have a proper curriculum to be followed which includes the latest research and findings by famous environmentalists. Every month kids are learning about an element of nature like soil, water, air, etc. where the younger kids are feeling and doing fun activities related to it, while the older ones are doing research and presenting their views in the form of articles and journals.
- **Water and sanitation** - Under ECP children are understanding that every drop of water matters and learning to minimize the wastage of water in everyday life. They also learned how they can place a bottle in the flush tank and conserve water in every use. Higher grade children are doing 'Water Audit' in every six months where they make sure that not even a single drop is leaking from the taps or getting wasted. With this there is a plan of placing a 'Rain water Harvesting' Unit in the school within a year or two.
- **Energy** - Children are getting stars to turn off the lights and fans of their class and conserve energy on their level. Other than that they are learning to use solar power as well.
- **Biodiversity and Greening** - To understand the importance of each and every plant and animals they are playing 'web of life' from the early years. Children are concerned about not polluting the environment so that they can save the biodiversity around them as all the plants and animals are interconnected. Every year we are organizing plantation drive where children are bringing saplings from home and planting them in school. Other than that on their birthdays also they are donating plants to the school.

- Culture and Heritage - To learn more about the culture of our country, every year children are presenting the culture of different states in colourful costumes from their state with famous dishes and dances.
- Waste management - We have a waste management unit and a compost pit, where all the vegetable peels and waste from the school canteen is used to make organic manure for the plants present in school. All the papers are always used from both the sides and waste papers are changed into paper mache, where kids are making different items out of it, sometimes handmade paper also.
- Source of information for conducting activities:
- Bhatnagar from Shri Educare Ltd. who is a famous environmentalist also. Other than that Mr. Bittoo Sehgal, head of Sanctuary Asia magazine is also helping us time to time. Our teachers are in direct contact with Earth Day Network and attending all their webinars to enhance their knowledge of the subject.
